OUT OF BOUNDS:

Beyond fences or stakes bounding property.

PRAIRIE GRASS RULE-

This local rule should be played unless otherwise directed by Tournament Committee.


When a ball is driven into prairie grass, if the player does not wish to play the ball as it lies, he may:

- 1. Replay the ball from it's original position with a penalty stroke and distance.
- 2. Drop the ball out of the prairie grass, not more than two club lengths from where the ball last crossed the margin of the grass and not nearer the hole. Penalty one stroke. This may be done whether or not ball is found.
